### LENTEN REGULATIONS

**ABSTINENCE:** The Church requires all the faithful who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> year of age to abstain from meat on **Ash Wednesday** (February 17) and **all Fridays** of Lent.

**FASTING:** All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are also bound to observe the fasting regulation on **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday**. This practice involves limiting oneself to a **single full meal** and **avoiding food between meals**. Light sustenance may also be taken on **two other occasions** in the course of the day.

**EASTER DUTY:** After they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion **at least once a year**. This precept must be fulfilled—unless for a good reason—from the **First Sunday of Lent** (February 21) to **Trinity Sunday** (May 30)

**THE FOLLOWING SHOULD ALSO BE NOTED:** By divine law, all the faithful are required to do penance. The obligation to observe the penitential days specified by the Church is a serious one. In addition, all other Fridays of the year remain as days of penance in prayerful remembrance of the Passion of Jesus Christ. While abstinence in a true spirit of penance is commended, each individual may substitute for that tradition some other practice of voluntary self-denial or personal penance, such as acts of mortification, temperance, prayer or charity.
